Through the clinic’s research activities and education programs, we hope to contribute to the well-being of those who suffer from cognitive issues and help patients’ families feel they have contributed to the health and welfare of the next generation,” declared Dr. Jennifer Ingram, Founder of the Kawartha Regional Memory Clinic.
